During the 90 days of the brutal war, we received a severe "national traumatology": hundreds and thousands of injuries and violent atrocities against civilian civilians. Murders and injuries of children and mothers are beyond comprehension and perception. Today, in the deep rear in the Lviv region, the front of the "struggle for life" is bravely held by our doctors. They are visited daily by the seriously injured, but fortunately alive, defenders of our country affected by hot spots of Donetsk, Luhansk, Kherson, Kharkiv, Zaporozhye. Dozens of women with small children in their arms lost their arms during the bombing. Spiritual and physical rehabilitation of Ukrainian mothers is extremely important today. It is everyone's responsibility to earn and help! Ukrainian artists, having art as a weapon, are ready to donate their works to a noble cause.

The idea of the art project is simple – to raise funds for prostheses for Ukrainian mothers who must continue to live and care for their young children!

We received artworks (paintings & sculptures) from more than 20 artists, valued at 500 € to 6.000 € that are sold in the exhibition as well as online and also in our finissage & auction event.
